GBO-3 Launched



On 10 May 2010, the third edition of Global Biodiversity Outlook (GBO-3) was launched in a number of cities around the world, including Alexandria, Bonn, Brasilia, Chamonix, Geneva, London, Manama, Montreal, New York, Nai-

robi, Panama, and Tokyo. This much anticipated flagship publication of the CBD is the product of close collaboration between the Secretariat of the CBD and the UNEP-WCMC. The report is based on scientific assessments, national reports submitted by governments and a study on future scenarios for biodiversity. Subject to an extensive independent scientific review process, publication of GBO-3 is one of the principal milestones of the United Nation's International Year of Biodiversity. The GBO-3 will be a key input into discussions by world leaders and heads of state at a special high level segment of the U.N. General Assembly on 22 September. Its conclusions will also be central to the negotiations by world governments at the Nagoya Biodiversity Summit in October. Mr. Jean Lemire, the biologist, explorer and film-maker from Quebec, Canada, has been appointed as ambassador of The Green Wave. In 2007, Mr. Lemire was appointed Officer of the Order of Canada for his contribu-

mental issues. In 2006, he completed a 15-month voyage to the Antarctic on the Sedna IV, a unique 51 metre full-rigged yacht with high-precision scientific and filming equipment. The voyage was documented in his film The Last Continent. Students in hundreds of schools followed the expedition through satellite and internet links to learn about the vulnerability of marine and polar ecosystems. His next multi-year voyage on Sedna IV, planned to begin in the fall of 2010, will focus on biodiversity and involve schools and communities taking part in The Green Wave. This year, Mr. Lemire helped get the International Year of Biodiversity off to a flying start in Montreal with the stage production *Paradis Perdu* that he co-produced with Dominic Champagne and Daniel Bélanger, and
