### GLOBAL OUTCOME-ORIENTED TARGETS FOR THE PROGRAMMES OF WORK ON THE BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY OF DRY AND SUB HUMID LANDS

Relationships between the framework goals and targets and activities of the programmes of work

#### I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. Draft global outcome-oriented targets for the programme of work on the biological diversity of dry and sub-humid lands were considered at the eleventh meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice (SBSTTA). Recommendation XI/1 provides the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP) with detailed advice on this matter from SBSTTA (UNEP/CBD/COP/8/3). Paragraph 2 of that recommendation requests the Executive Secretary to prepare a matrix relating the goals and targets of the programme of work on dry and sub-humid lands to the activities in the programme of work for consideration by the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
- 2. This document has been prepared by the Executive Secretary in order to provide the Conference of the Parties with the required information.
  - II. RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN THE FRAMEWORK GOALS AND TARGETS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK ON THE BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY OF DRY AND SUB HUMID LANDS
- 3. The framework of goals and targets in recommendation XI/1 are cross-referenced to the activities in the programme of work on biological diversity dry and sub-humid lands in the matrix in annex.

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4. The matrix indicates that there is generally good correspondence between activities in the programme of work and goals targets in recommendation XI/1. Nonetheless, target 4.2 (unsustainable consumption, of biological resources, or that impacts upon biodiversity, reduced), and target 4.3, (no species of wild flora or fauna endangered by international trade) do not have direct supporting activities in the programme of work. Some targets were better covered by activities of the programme of work than others. For example, target 8.1 - capacity of ecosystems to deliver goods and services maintained - is covered by a large number of activities and sub-activities. Lastly, it is worth highlighting that Activity 8(e) (Policies and instruments) is essential to the achievement of all goals and targets.
