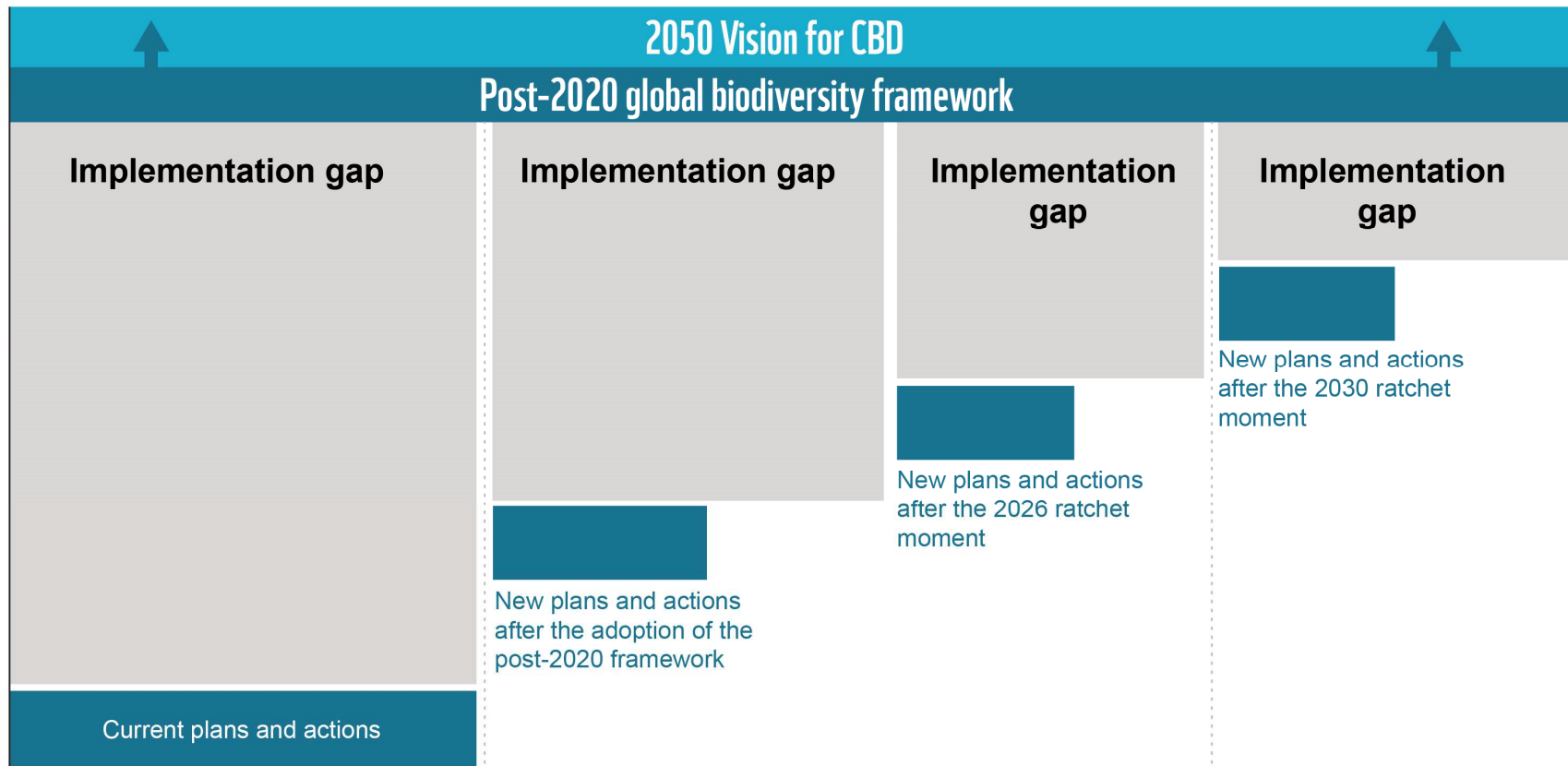


WWF Proposal for an effective and robust "Implementation mechanism"

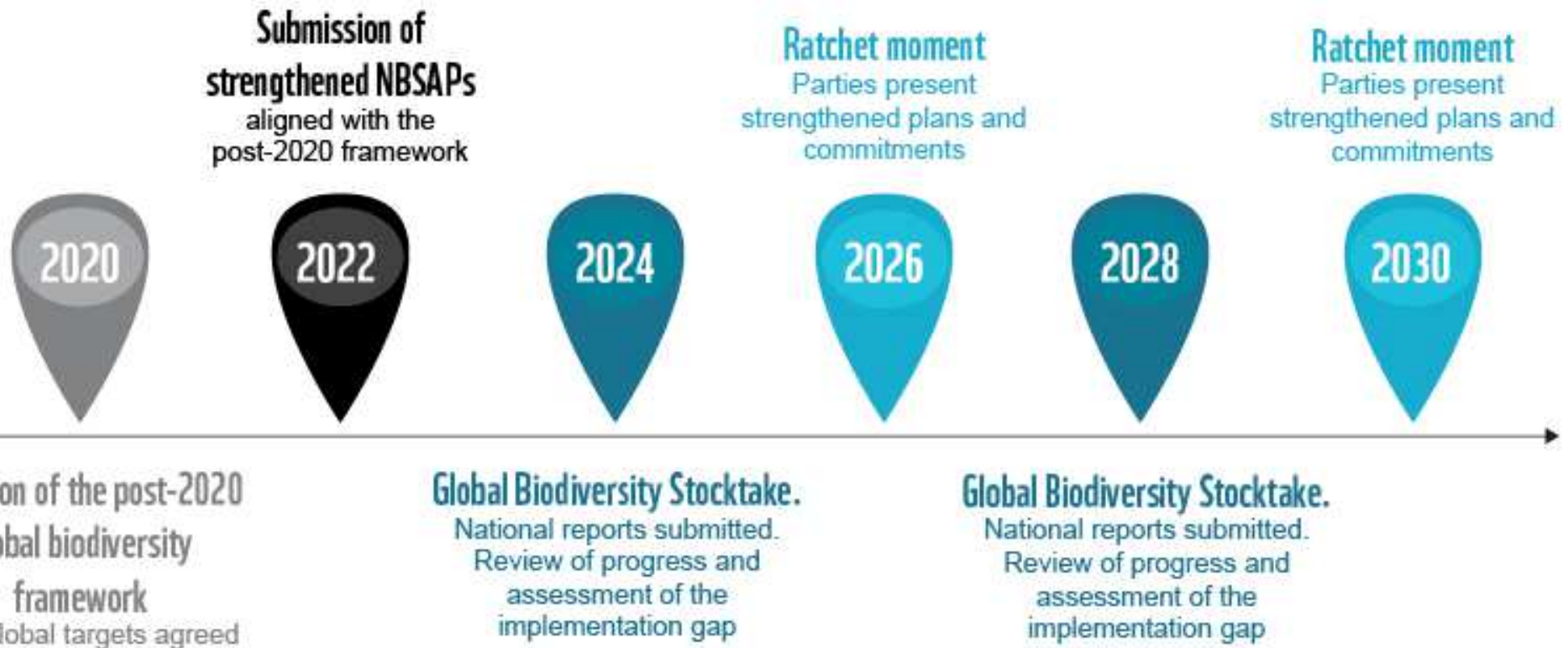

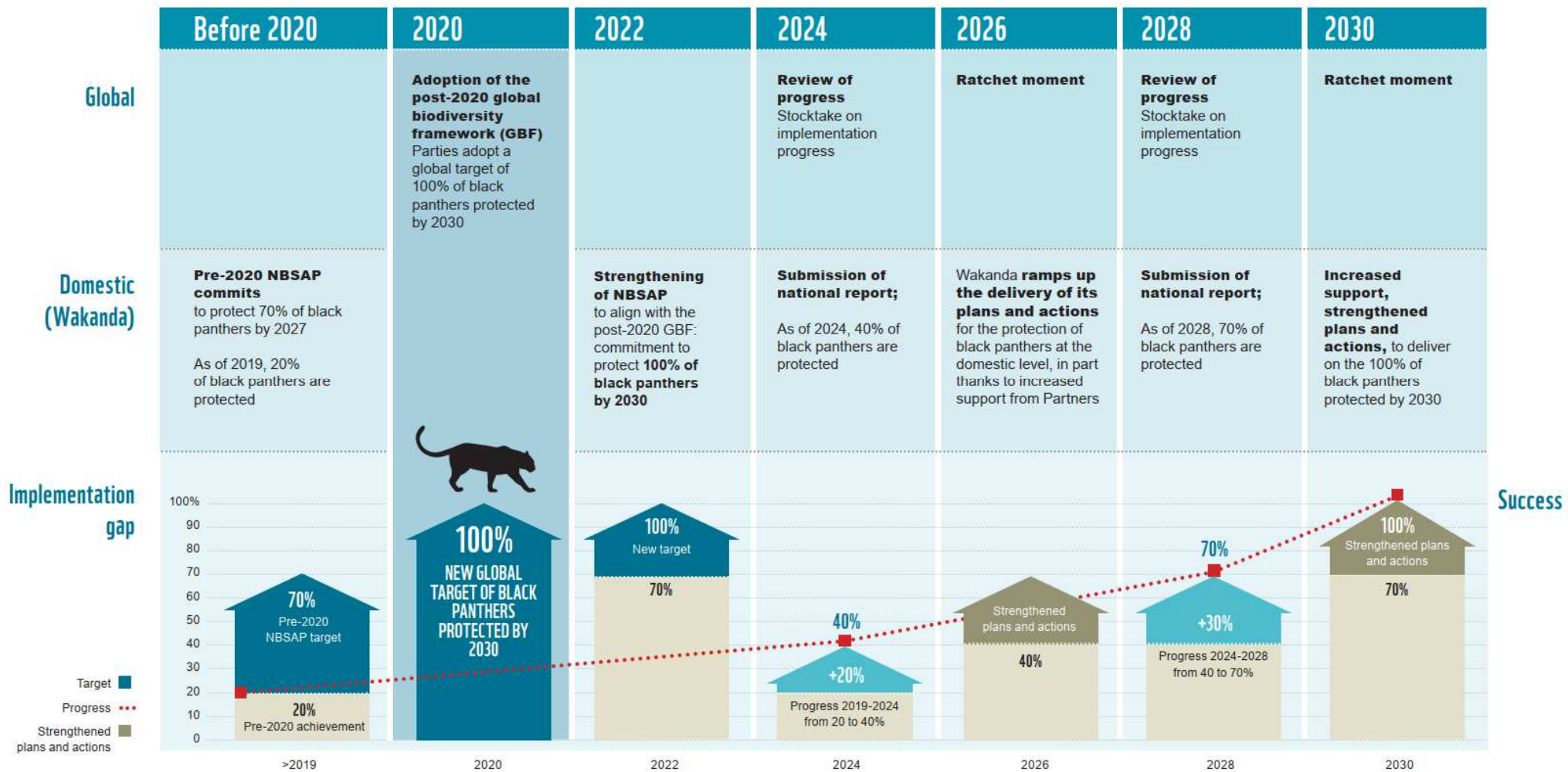


WWF proposal : present, review, ratchet (and repeat)

- 1** **Present**: putting forward national biodiversity actions based on strengthened **NBSAPs** aligned with the post-2020 global biodiversity framework and its global targets.
- 2** **Review**: reviewing the implementation of the framework with updated **national reports**, and then regularly assessing progress during a **global biodiversity stocktake**.
- 3** **Ratchet**: strengthening the delivery of biodiversity plans and actions, to **progressively close the implementation gap**.

The implementation mechanism, an integral part of the post-2020 framework: some suggestions

1

Provide significant space for implementation, including the implementation mechanism, in the discussions and negotiations for the adoption of the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework.

Use the thematic consultation to:

- Outline the **key components** of an effective implementation mechanism **to be delivered at COP15**;
- Ensure a **shared understanding on terminologies** pertaining to the implementation mechanism;
- Lay out a **clear roadmap** on how best to use the in-sessional and inter-sessional period to achieve concrete deliverables at COP15.

Connect the implementation mechanism to the other aspects of implementation, including resource mobilization and stakeholder engagement.
